Local charities that KDBC has supported in the recent past include:



## An Interesting Hand (discussion by Don Kersey)



When the auction begins 1H-1S-2D, North can use the following tip: if a perfect minimum holding for partner will make slam cold, then it is worth exploring for slam. Here North can imagine South having x Axxxx AKxxx xx, a minimum on which even grand slam is a good bet, so North should be willing to bid slam unless there aren't enough keycards.

On the auction given (slightly cut off in the screen shot above), North bid 3C, fourth suit forcing, and South showed the fifth diamond, so North asked for keycards and stopped in 6D, making 7 when the king of trumps was onside.

# Need a partner? You can play with a Bot on BBO!

If you and your partner have scheduling problems, or something comes up—no worries! Now you can play with a Bot partner in KDBC Virtual Club Games. Players who have done this report that it has been fun, and the Bots are both very good players and very polite.
