

\$8 per person per '99er or '299er session' \$12 per person per Open session \$96 Swiss Team (both sessions, all players)

Players need an ACBL # to play. Free memberships are available for non-members (contact the Club). Lapsed ACBL members add \$4 per session.

- ♥ If a player registers for a '99er or '299er session that is not held due to insufficient entries, that player has the option of playing in the Open session offered at that time at no extra cost, or a refund.
- ♣ All games award 80% Silver + 20% Black MPs at 100% Sectional rating. All games subject to sufficient entries. Stratification: none/1500/500 (Open games); 300/100/50 ('299er games); 100/50/20 ('99er games); based on average MPs. Stratification may be changed by the D-I-C.
