## Inquiring about opponents carding

The only supported way to do this is as follows, as mandated by ACBL:

- Click one of the opponent's player names

- When you do that, the chat window will appear, like the following

Notice the Chat button becomes active once you start to type and the magic word which should be used when asking anyone to do anything, please (2).

- Click Chat or press Enter to send the message.

You must do exactly as documented in the above and below as it is the only approach that dos does not provide unauthorized information to your partner.
