

This short document will assist players making the transition from the text-based results display on our previous website to the graphical display on the new site. They are exactly the same, as show in this document. Even better, the new site shows many important items that were not available prior to the move:

1. The E/W pair number being played
2. What the contract was
3. The opening lead
4. Tricks taken
5. N/S and E/W scores in their own columns ... the previous site was from the perspective of N/S and reported E/W scores prefixed by the minus sign (-)

Now to analyze a few boards ... the next few pages compare the sites' results for boards 1, 2, and 5 ...

Let's look at the similarity between the two readouts:

- Old site shows Board #1 played by N/S pair 1, 5, 6, 7, 8, 9, 10 (reading horizontally)
- New site shows Board #1 played by N/S pair 1, 5, 6, 7, 8, 9, 10 (reading vertically)
- Old site shows
 - Scores 150, 50, PASS, 50, PASS, 100, 120 (reading horizontally)

- All scores are from the perspective of N/S (positive scores being N/S and negative being E/W)
- New site shows
 - Scores 150, 50, PASS, 50, PASS, 100, 120 (reading vertically)
 - All score being for N/S since they fall in the **+Sc** column

Let's look at the similarity between the two readouts:

- Old site shows Board #2 played by N/S pair 1, 5, 6, 7, 8, 9, 10 (reading horizontally)
- New site shows Board #2 played by N/S pair 1, 5, 6, 7, 8, 9, 10 (reading vertically)
- Old site shows
 - Scores -130, -130, -130, -130, -150, -150, -150 (reading horizontally)

- All scores are from the perspective of N/S (positive scores being N/S and negative being E/W); these scores are all for E/W, hence they are negative.
- New site shows
 - Scores 130, 130, 130, 130, 150, 150, 150 (reading vertically)
 - All scores being for E/W since they fall in the **-Sc** column

Let's look at the similarity between the two readouts:

- Old site shows Board #5 played by N/S pair 1, 2, 6, 7, 8, 9, 10 (reading horizontally)
- New site shows Board #5 played by N/S pair 1, 2, 6, 7, 8, 9, 10 (reading vertically)
- Old site shows
 - Scores 100, -300, -300, 150, 500, -200, -200 (reading horizontally)

- All scores are from the perspective of N/S (positive scores being N/S and negative being E/W); these scores are all for E/W, hence they are negative.
- New site shows
 - Scores 100, **300**, **300**, 150, 500, **200**, **200** (reading vertically)
 - The E/W scores are **bold and underlined** in the previous bullet point, showing in the **-Sc**

Hence, one can get identical information from the new site as was available on the old, and then a lot more.
