## Khalid Kattan-Tahir Masood

Basic System: 2/1

15-17 NT. 4-way transfers. 2S for C and 2NT for D. breaking transfers shows super acceptance.

1NT 3M shows shortness in the bid major and 4-5 or 5-4 in the minors.

Smolen also applicable after 1NT openeing

J2N. New suit after J2N shows shortness. Jumping to game shows no slam interest. Rebid of major shows slam interest and denies shortness. Jump to new suit shows 5-5.

RKCB 1430. Next step, if not the agreed suit is trump queen ask. Fiesr step denies queen. 2<sup>nd</sup> step shows queen. New suit at 6 level shows queen and the king of that suit. After interference over 4NT we play DOPI. Double=0, Pass=1, next step 2 without queen and the next step 2 with queen. A jump to 6 of a new minor shows odd number of key cards and a void in that suit. A 5NT response to 4NT shows even number of key cards and a useful void.

2C Drury after 3<sup>rd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> hand opening. Rebid by opener shows less than opening hand. 2D by opener is waiting and shows a non-minimum opening. New suit is natural. Jump to new suit is 5-5 with slam interest.

Reverse Bergen by unpassed hand. 3C being stronger than 3D.

Splinter by responder shows min 4 cards support and 8-10/11 points.

Simple 2C checkback after 1NT rebid by opener.

If opener bids 2 suits, he shows min 5-4. So 1C 1H, 1S by opener shows 5C and 4S. With 4-4 or 3-4 we will rebid 1NT.

Responder can always check for 4 card major through checkback if interested in game.

Capelletti over opponents 1NT.

Constructive weak 2 openings. After a weak 2M and 2NT by responder the responses are

3C = bad suit, bad hand.

3D= good hand bad suit

3H= good suit bad hand

3S = good suit and good hand

3NT= suit showing AKQxxx

4 new suit= shows 6-5 hand

After 2D opening and 2NT by responder, the responses are:

3C= any good hand

3D= weak hand

3M= natural 4 cards

White against red, 1<sup>st</sup> hand opening of 3 of a suit can be very weak.

Q10xxxx x Jxxx Qx. Open 3S 1<sup>st</sup> or 3<sup>rd</sup> hand white against red. Any other vulnerability, pass.

New suit after a weak 2 or 3 opening is 1 round force.

UDCA. 4<sup>th</sup> best leads. On partner's lead we first show attitude and not count.

Lead A from AK.

Michaels over opponents' openings. Must be minimum 5-5. Inverted minors. 1C-2C must have min 5 cards. 1D-2D can be with 4 cards. After interference over our 1NT bid, we play lebensohl. Examples: YOU OPP PARTNER 1NT 2 any 2NT (Lebensohl). Partner is expected to bid 3C. Now 3 new suit is weak and a sign off 3 opponent's suit shows no check and 4 card other major. 3NT shows game going values with NO CHECK. YOU OPP PARTNER 1NT 2C dbl= stayman YOU OPP PARTNER 1NT 2 any 3 new suit= natural and game forcing 1NT 2 any 3 cue= shows 4 cards other major and denies check 1NT 2any 2NT 3C p 3NT shows check.

After opponents weak 2 bid and a double by us, 2NT by partner is lebensohl and asks partner to bid 3C which can be passed or corrected. This shows less than 8 points. So after a double if partner bids a suit he shows 9-11 points. With more points he can jump or cue bid.

In competitive bidding, if we over call and jump raise by partner is preemptive. With strong support, we will first cue bid.

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
