

How to Vote in the BCOH Election Online

Follow the steps below to vote in this year's BCOH Election.

NOTE: You will see the actual candidate names when you vote.

1. Log into your BridgeWebs account at www.bridgewebs.com/bcoh

A. In the left menu, click **LOG IN HERE / Account Info**



B. Enter your ACBL number and password¹

A. Click the Account tab to view your profile



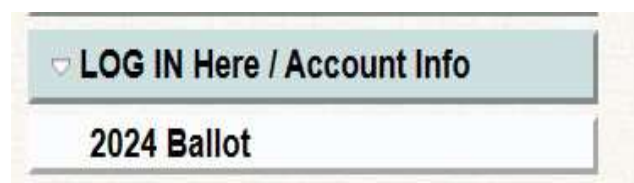
B. Scroll down to the Voter PIN field, just above your picture



C. Make a note of your 6 digit Voter PIN

3. Go to the 2024 ballot

A. In the left menu, click 2023 Ballot. It is a sub-menu of the LOG IN HERE / Account Info menu.



4. Submit your vote

- A. Scroll down to the bottom of the ballot.
- B. Enter your ACBL Number, Voter PIN and email address.
