
Responding to No Trump Openers – Part 3

Texas Transfer (6* Spades and game-going values)

BBO Robots play this

1NT – Pass – 4D* transfers partner to 4H, and 1NT – Pass – 4H* to 4S.

2NT - Pass - 4D* transfers partner to 4H, and <math>2NT - Pass - 4H* to 4S.

Texas Transfer (6* Hearts and game-going values)

So, what's the difference between Texas and Jacoby Transfer bids?

- 1) Jacoby can be a 5+-card major and Texas is always a 6+-card major, and:
- 2) Since Texas takes up more bidding room, it denies any interest in slam:

Smolen



After 1NT, Smolen is for game-going hands that are 5-4 or 4-5 in the majors.

North **East** South West ??? 1NT **Pass**

What do you bid?: South

♦KQ982 **♥**QJ53 **♦**2 **♣**K43

Start with Stayman (2C). If partner rebids a major, jump to game in it.

If partner rebids 2D, jump in your 4-card major (forcing to game):

West North South East 1NT **Pass** 2C **Pass** 3H* **2D Pass Pass** ???

With game-going values.


Playing Smolen, partner will know you have 4 of the major you bid and 5 of the other one.

In this way, the strongest hand (1NT opener) will play the hand (usually in 3NT or your 5-card major).

BBO Robots play this

Smolen also applies after partner opens 2NT.

Do **NOT** use Smolen after 1NT to **invite** to game.

Not part of Smolen.

After 1NT, what do you bid with?:

South

♦KJ862 **♥**Q953 **♦**4 **♣**Q32

Bid 2C.

If partner bids a major, raise that major.

Not part of Smolen.

If partner rebids 2D, bid your 5-card major (inviting to game):

North East South West **2C Pass** 1NT **Pass** 2S* **2D Pass**


Another Joke

We asked our daughter to use Photoshop to make this photo more interesting. Here's what she came up with:



Lebensohl Over No Trump

When they bid over your 1NT opener, partner will no longer have 2NT to invite to 3NT with. He should just double the opponents with 8-9 HCP's.



BBO Robots play Lebensohl.

By transferring your partner to 3C first and then bidding a higher-ranking major, you show invitational values with a 5+-card suit.





Lebensohl (Cont'd)

The Rule when using Lebensohl is "Slow Shows, Fast Denies (a stopper)."

BBO Robots play this

After:

North East South West 1NT 2H ???

3) Game values with a 4-card major and no stopper in their suit:

North East South West

1NT 2H 3H* Pass

???

A cue bid of their suit becomes Stayman with no stopper in their suit (because you went the FAST way).

4) Game values with a 4-card major and a stopper in their suit:

North East South West

1NT 2H 2NT* Pass

3C* Pass 3H* Pass
???

Transferring partner to 3C and then cue bidding their suit becomes Stayman (asking for a 4-card major) with a stopper in their suit (because you went the SLOW way).





Lebensohl (Cont'd)

The Rule when using Lebensohl is "Slow Shows" (a stopper).

BBO Robots play this

After:

North East South West 1NT 2H ???

5) Game values with no 4-card major and no stopper in their suit:

North East South West
1NT 2H 3NT* Pass
???

South ★KJ2 ♥53 ◆K942 ♣KJ82 3NT*

Jumping to 3NT shows game values, no 4-card major and no stopper in their suit (because you went the FAST way).

6) Game values with no 4-card major and a stopper in their suit:


