


"Don't bother me with your troubles," the third patron responded. "Just give me my change and I'll be on my way."




False Carding on Defense

Here's an example:







Another Defensive False Card

The farmer shouts back, "Why don't you show him your badge?"



False Carding When Declaring

Declaring

The concept of False Carding also applies to you playing misleading cards as declarer.

These are far more common than defensive false cards but are often overlooked by even advanced players. Get used to discarding higher cards than your lowest in a suit, so long as it doesn't cost you a trick. Defenders determine their plans of attack by their partners' leads and what you play.





My Best False Card as Declarer


