




Possible High Road Auctions



When is 2/1 Game Forcing Used?



Requirements:

- 1. One person must open one of a major.
- 2. The opponents must NOT be in the auction yet.
- 3. It must be the responder's FIRST chance to bid.

Question:

a)


What does North respond if he passed this hand?:

If he bids 4H, it's pre-emptive (3-7 HCPs with 5 hearts), and they could easily miss a slam.

- b) If he jumps to 3H, it's invitational, and they could easily miss a cold game.
- c) If he bids 2D, it's not forcing, since 2/1 GF is not used here.

Answer: He bids 2C*, which shows major suit support and 10+ HCPs. Then he bids game.

Don't forget you have the option of using Jacoby 2NT* with 4 trumps. It's more powerful than 2/1 GF.






