Time for A Joke


A worldwide survey was conducted by the UN. The only question asked was: "Would you please give your honest opinion about solutions to the food shortage in the rest of the world?"

Lead = $K \blacklozenge$

North

- **♦** 9875
- **>** 532
- **♦** 865
- **♣** AKQ

<u>East</u>

South – (DECLARER)

♥ KJ

♦A10

The K♦ is taken by declarer's ace.

Declarer gets to dummy with the **Q**♣ and leads the **2**♥, covering East's 8♥ with the J♥.

West takes the A♥ and cashes the Q♦.

West plays his 2♦, forcing East to ruff with his Q♥, setting up West's 9♥ – the setting trick.



West takes his K♣ and switches to his 8♥ - 10♥, K♥.

South plays the 7♣, ruffing in dummy and East overruffs.



East can expect another two high cards from West.

He should cash the K*, cross to his partner's A*.

West should then play another club, East uppercutting with his Q♠ to set up partner's K and 10 of trumps.
