A guy walks into a clinic. He has peas in his nose, a banana in one ear, a strawberry in his eye, and he says, "I don't feel so good!"



When you can take at least 4 more tricks playing in your long suit than you can defending, pre-empt!

Pre-empting helps you by:

- 1) Disrupting the opponents' bidding.
- 2) Finding sacrifices.
- 3) Helping your partner to lead.

If your partner rebids 3S, you should pass.

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How often do planes crash?

<u>Unusual vs. the Unusual</u> is a defence against two-suited pre-empts (Michaels and The Unusual No Trump).

1) When they <u>don't</u> show exactly which two suits they have (example: 1H − 2H), a bid of their suit (2S) shows a limit raise (11-12 HCPs) or better in partner's suit (♥'s). "Partner, I'm inviting you to game, or I'm looking for slam; you'll find out later."

2) When you know the opponent's two suits, cue bidding their <u>higher</u> suit shows a limit raise or better in partner's suit. Cue bidding their <u>lower</u> suit shows the 4th suit and 10⁺ HCPs. (*Some partnerships play this differently.)

'Your dad was a billionaire?" she asked.




A doctor made a mistake and unknowingly prescribed his patient a powerful laxative instead of cough drops.

At the end of the week the patient comes back for a check-up. The doctor asks him: "So how's it going, Mr. Kowalski? Do you still cough a lot?"


