## CBC Treasurer's Report for 2023-24

Current account funds are just around £7500. We have significantly reduced the figure wrt excess income over expenditure from nearly £3000 to just under £800. The value of our Business Reserve account is now over £10,000. This is due to the fact that interest rates have increased over the financial year.

We have continued with our monthly F2F Charity Events at the Millennium Centre Great Baddow and these games have proven to be enjoyable, even if attendance has been variable. Players continue to give generously to the nominated charity for the evening. The club continues to double all the amount collected for table money and uses Club funds to pay for the hire of the hall and refreshments.

We have collected just over £2000 for charities from members and the Club has donated nearly ~£5350 to good causes. This figure also includes donations when the Club has played in various Ecats/Sims events. (More than the table money for the Ecats/Sims evening has been donated and players have not been asked to contribute additional amounts.)

CBC Committee have decided that the table money will be reduced from £2.50 to £2. This will commence from June  $1^{st}$  2024.

Membership fee is currently £2 and should remain at £2. This will be collected on the first evening that a member plays on or after September 1<sup>st</sup> 2024. In addition, this then entitles the individual to play their first 2 games for free, providing they were members in 2023-24 and have been regular players. As a consequence of holding the monthly F2F charity evenings and the reduction in table money, the surplus of income over expenditure should continue to reduce.

In conclusion, the Club is in a healthy condition financially.
