Summer Thursday Special Pricing!

Pay only \$6 per person on Thursday afternoons during the first two weeks of July (that is, through July 11), and anyone who plays both Thursday sessions will get the discount for both (\$12 for two sessions of bridge!). Please join us, and feel free to bring baked goods.

The parking garage behind the building now charges for evening parking, and the attendant is staying later. The club does not benefit if you park in their lot, but it is still free if the attendant has left for the night.

Most on-street parking is free after 5 or 6 pm (in the pay-at-the-box spots). Plymouth Court between Harrison and Polk has many spots that are loading zones during the day and free nights and weekends. Don't park in resident parking without a sticker, and do check the closest box to be sure it is free. We also recommend installing the Spothero app on your phone to find the cheapest public parking in the area.

For those with safety concerns, just call the club and we will send someone to escort you to and from your car. Many evening players offer rides home to those who arrive by public transportation, so safety should not be a concern, particularly since the South Loop has become one of the safest areas in the City of Chicago.

NAPs Are Back!

National American Pairs (NAP) season is a special time in the annual ACBL calendar. If you are a decent C-flight pair (non-Life Master) or B-flight (<2500), this is your moment to shine, and bring pride and honor to District 13. The top two regional qualifiers in each flight will receive a stipend to attend the national final in Memphis in March (essentially airfare and hotel).

To qualify for the district final in Milwaukee in October, you need a club qualification. CDB offers NAP-Qual[ifying] games alternating weeks in June, July, and August, all of which award double Masterpoints, both red and black. The extra dollar charged funds our district winners.

You can play in the District final with anyone who has a club-Q. So don't forget to play! This is a rare opportunity to win money within the ACBL.

Online NAP Quals will be held the first Monday of June, July, and August.

If you are looking for more chances to play in a limited-MP game, consider joining our Friday afternoon 750/NLM ((non-Life Master) game.

CDB offers Supervised Play at 10:30 for \$5, followed by a short break for lunch and a shortened (usually 18- or 21-board) 750/NLM game at 12:15. This game now regularly has **at least 4 full tables**, so there's a nice spirit of friendly competition. But **you do NOT have to attend the Supervised Play to join the game.** If you come to both, there is no charge for the Supervised Play. This is a great way to practice and see the rules you have learned in actual use. The atmosphere is relaxed and supportive. It's also a great way to meet potential partners, so don't be afraid to come without a partner arranged in advance.
