League Structure for 2024-25 Season SECTIONS

Masters: Premier Masters (Team playing with one or more players with 40 National Pts)

Area Masters (Teams playing with all players with less than 40 National Pts)

Intermediate "A1": (Teams playing with all players with less than 10 National Pts)

"A2": (Teams playing with all players with less than 5 National Pts)

Intermediate "B": (Teams playing with all players with less than 2 National Pts)

Novice: (Teams playing with players with less than 5000 Local Pts or 5 years from start of Lessons)

Sections will be identified as following PM, AM, A1, A2, B, Novice

The MLR Committee has the right to alter sections depending on number of teams enterer

The Goal is to have six section winners

Every Team will play 6 matches where possible. Teams will play Swiss system or head-to-head in each section depending on numbers.

Boards Played: PM, AM, A1 will play 24 Boards / A2 will 22 Boards / B will play 20 boards

Novice will play 18 Boards

These are the maximum number of boards. Match will be played as 2 sessions, e.g.12brds/12brds - 11brds/11brds - 10brds/10brds - 9brds/9brds

There may be adjustments if TD sees fit for the good of the matches.

Scoring: Official scoring will be entered and agreed on Bridgemates

Teams will be supplied with score sheets & conversion sheets (IMPs to VP's)

Note Teams disputing scores must have completed score sheet. If no score sheets both teams

must agree on adjustment with TD.

Matchday Results will be published on League website when play is completed. Results will be posted as IMP scores and will be converted and checked by committee.

All Matchday Dates & Fixtures will be published on League Website
Venue All Matches will be Westmanstown Sports Centre All Matches start at 7.00pm
All Teams in each section will receive copy of League Rules.

Clubs may enter any number of Teams in each section. No player may play or sub for more than one team. Players must be members of club played for and Affiliated with CBAI/MLR.

Team may only use six players in a season, you are entitled to use all players in a match.

Change of player cannot be made during session.

In Extenuating Circumstances teams may be allowed to play additional players

But team must receive clearance from the MLR Committee

Failure to do so could result in points deduction

The MLR Committee will have the final say in resolving all League Dispute
