### REPORTING RESULTS

### TIME TAKEN FOR A MATCH

The maximum time for a match of 24 boards is 2x 84 minutes, with a short break for half-time. The maximum time for a match of 20 boards is 2 x 70 minutes, with a short break for half-time. The default is 24 boards, but teams may choose to just play 20 boards.

In the event that a team exceeds the time for a match, a penalty may be applied.

In the event of a team withdrawing from the league part-way through the competition, the team defaults all its matches.
