A. By-law change: Section 4.3.1.2

Currently: "Members of the Board of Directors may not serve on the Audit Committee."

Proposal: Keep the current language.

Proposal: Members of the Board of Directors, with the exception of the Treasurer, may not serve on the Audit committee.

Amendment of the By-Laws: "Amendments to the by-laws may be made by.....petition signed by at least three members of the Board of Directors."

"The concurrence of two-thirds of all Members present and voting shall be required to pass any amendment." This is done on a bridge day before the game begins.

Translation: If the board determines a need for the above by-law change, three board members must make the request, then the change must be announced and posted 10 days before 2/3 of the members present at a meeting (Christmas Party or Team Game?) vote on the amendment.
