Progress and Collaboration

Key Achievements

- Planning Consent & Building Warrant: Early December brought crucial progress, with both our Planning Consent and Building Warrant successfully approved. These achievements allow us to begin obtaining contractor quotes.
- **Preparation for Ownership:** With the formal acquisition of the Clyde Bridge Centre scheduled for the end of February, we are on track to commence essential transformation works promptly upon ownership transfer.

- **Membership Application:** The application form, agreed upon during our last IG meeting, will soon be distributed to all members. It will be accessible online or available for download to submit via Club Secretaries.
- Fees: The membership fee has been set at £40 per year, alongside the £12 annual
 Scottish Bridge Union (SBU) membership fee.
- Membership Period: First-year membership will be valid until June 2026. Information on application availability will be sent within the next two weeks.

Call for Trustees and Volunteers

We encourage members to consider standing as Trustees. As a SCIO (Scottish Charitable Incorporated Organisation), we need committed individuals to help manage our responsibilities as a charity. Additionally, we seek a part-time Building Manager with services skills to manage the routine maintenance and repair of the building and equipment. Knowledge of buildings and/or building services would be useful, but is not essential. This role will require only a few hours per week and will be remunerated.

Community Engagement

To foster camaraderie among members of all three clubs, we will hold monthly "Getting to Know You" bridge tournaments. These events are designed to help members connect and build relationships before we formally gather in the new club. The first which will be held in the Buchanan Club on 2nd February at 1.00pm.
