# Did you know?

#### **Entering the lead is important**

You are prompted to enter the lead into the BridgeTab.

This information is useful for everyone who checks their results. Often the lead is an important factor in the result. We record to add to the value of checking the detail of the result.

The lead can also help us when a result is recorded incorrectly. If the declarer choice seems wrong, the lead can help to work out what really happened.

We need you to enter the opening lead, and enter it correctly.

These days our scoring system checks the given opening lead against the hand record and TELLS YOU if it doesn't make sense. (It also tells the TD with a message on the laptop.)

#### Please don't ignore this message.

Please go back, check the contract and declarer and correct the entry until the BridgeTab is happy with the lead. Do call us if you need help. This saves us getting messages after the session and sometimes having to correct the record and reissue the result.

### **Recycling pill blister packs**


I am recycling empty pill blister packs. They have no financial value. They can be recycled, for a fee.
