# Recycling pill blister packs Club Timetable

On Mondays we usually get enough tables to play two-board rounds.

### Your next position is displayed on the tablet

After you have checked the result of the last board in your round, the tablet will display the current rankings and then it will show the table and direction for the next round for each pair.

Sometimes this is obvious, "players up, boards down". Sometimes we have to use a more complex movement.

North should make sure that both pairs know where they are going, and that each sets off in the right direction.

### Recycling pill blister packs

I am recycling empty pill blister packs. They have no financial value.

They can be recycled, for a fee.

This keeps them out of landfill and least partially recycled.

We filled **SIX** bags so far.
