

The Broke Cup is the county, green pointed, knock out cup for teams of four. The Betts Bowl is the plate competition for those teams that lose their first round match.

Matches of 32 boards are played face to face or online if both captains agree.

Teams of four is a great format for competitive bridge and playing in a county event, such as this, is an opportunity to meet and compete with players from different clubs.
