The bid of 1S here only promises 4.	1H - 2D - P - P - X This is a reopening double by the opener in case partner who passed has a Diamond stack and wants to convert to penalty. If you don't want to convert to penalty, make your best bid which might be to put your partner is a 5/2 fit in their major.	1C – 1S – X You cannot bid Hearts directly at the 2-level because you do not have enough points. So you need to make a negative double to show the Heart suit.

The bid of 1S here would usually show less than 10 points with 4+ Spades.
