September 2024, the Melville Bridge Academy is offering a course of general revision. It includes a variety of topics on bidding and card play. The course will appeal to those who are in the latter stages – or recent finishers – of the SBU course, as well as club members who would like to brush up on some vital parts of the game. The course details are shown below

- ➤ Sept 24 No-trump bidding and continuations; the vital Stayman and Transfers
- ➤ Oct 1 No-trump bidding with strong hands; including 2NT opening bids.
- > Oct 8 Declarer play in No-trumps; "CWP", analysing the lead, suit establishment.
- ➤ Oct 15 Defending No-trump contracts; Leading listen to the bidding, choosing the correct card, defensive communications etc!
- Oct 22 Bidding unbalanced hands (1); The purpose of bidding describe your hand to your partner!
- > Oct 29 Bidding unbalanced hands (2); Continuing the theme from last week
- ➤ Nov 5 Declarer play in Suit contracts; Counting losers; timing drawing trumps, making those vital extra tricks.
- ➤ Nov 12 Defending Suit contracts; How to choose the best leads and how to approach the defence
- ➤ Nov 19 'Weak 2s'. A vital bidding tool; opening, responding, defending.
- ➤ Nov 26 The Overcall; How to use it, and how to combat it!
- ➤ Dec 3 Our 'flexible friend' the take-out double! ; A much under-used and useful bid
- ➤ **Dec 10 Slam Bidding**; Roman Key-card Blackwood in all of its glory
