Hands from the Trenches:

Steven will take hands played at NWTBC that required more than a little thought to arrive at the right solution. All three parts of the game bidding, declaring, defending -- may come into the discussion. We'll publicize the date and the board number of each hand before each class. Keep your results; and if you played these, note how you did, what you might have done. He'll make you a better player by always focusing on the theme: How to THINK ABOUT a bridge hand. And make no mistake: When you think the right thoughts, you win more!

Bidbetterbidbetter: Gayle loves to teach bidding. Over and over, we note that players have the first two or three bids down...then they're lost in the trenches. Recently at the Club, we could tell from the final contract that only one pair (including the A side) knew how to bid a basic hand pattern. Crazy!, I said. You CANNOT win if you don't arrive at the right contract! I promise I'll make this fun.

Improving Your Defense: Kay will teach 5 lessons on Defense – widely assumed to be the hardest part of the game. There are basic premises – which card you lead, which card you play, which suit you attack, which suit you don't attack. She'll help you get there. And EVERYTHING about defense underscores this fact: IT'S A PARTNERSHIP GAME.

Bob Hertzog will teach two classes – both covering convention that will help you handle competitive auctions. Our popular Director of Education always helps you improve your game.
