

Bridge arrangements

- 7 rounds of 7 boards (or 6 x 8, depending on entry; teams event will be Swiss if enough entries, else green pointed multiple teams)
- Level 4
- 30 minutes' break after round 3
- Finish approximately 6.30pm
- Prizes to top 10% of field
- Master points will be credited directly
- Results will be posted promptly on B&BCBA website

- Pay in advance by bank transfer (see website)
- Please don't show up without having entered!
