Summary of Tollemache Performance 2023-24

Four teams qualify for the Tollemache final each year from each of two groups. Oxfordshire came fifth in the green group, narrowly missing out on qualification to Cambridgeshire by just 2VPs. Diana and Ollie, and Charlie and Ewa had outstanding performances against strong opposition.

Selection Criteria

As in previous years the Selection Committee agreed criteria for assessment for pairs to be selected to represent Oxfordshire in the Tollemache. The criteria are dependent 60% on the votes of the committee members, and 40% on the statistics available from the EBU website as follows:

Vote required:

Partnership strength - 50% Contributions to the county - 10%

No vote:

Partnership NGS - 20% Individual NGS - 10% Gold points - 10%

The voting instructions to committee members were as follows: Please, provide a numerical score to each pair on the two categories - partnership strength and contributions to the county. The score should be on the scale from 1 to 7 with 1 being highest (best) and 7 being lowest (worst). Please, rank your own pair if playing - score will be discounted in the rankings. Ideally, each pair should get a different score (therefore utilizing all numbers from 1 to 7) at least on the partnership strength indicator but in case you'd like to rank several pairs equally, feel free to give them the same rank. Please, make sure to start the ranks from 1 downwards (so 1112345 preferred to 3334567).

The votes of the committee members are secret from each other, and the number of pairs selected was chosen following the ranking described.
