Individual Members

Members receive the following from the County:

- A web site providing a comprehensive range of constantly updated information about bridge in the County including the competitions calendar, competition results and facilities for member feedback.
- A full range of opportunities for competitive bridge, face-to-face and online, covering pairs and teams at all levels of ability and experience, from events for those who have just learned the game through to the most prestigious national competitions.
- Learning and development opportunities for all, including young people.
- Advice on all bridge matters, playing and organising.
- Advice on disciplinary matters.
- Publication of minutes of all County committee meetings via the County web site creating awareness of current issues and actions being taken.
- Personal e-mail communications on matters of interest to those who have registered an email address.
- An opportunity to participate in elections and raise matters of interest at the SCCBA Annual General Meeting.
- Representation in English Bridge Union forums through the County's EBU shareholders.

Members pay a small charge per session for County services, currently 7p and held at that level since 2012. This is collected through the EBU Universal Membership Scheme and is included in the table money collected at affiliated clubs.

Affiliated Clubs

Affiliated Clubs receive the following from the County:

- Publication of Club sessions, facilities and contacts on the County website.
- Information on all County events and help with organising heats of County competitions.
- Publicity for events which clubs wish to be open to other Sussex clubs' members.
- Regular e-mail communications on matters of interest.
- Publication of minutes of all committee meetings via the County web site
- Advice on all bridge matters, playing, organising, directing and administration.
- Advice on disciplinary matters.
- Dealing with club disciplinary matters where requested.
- The opportunity to send delegates to SCCBA Management Committee meetings.
- Representation in EBU forums.
- An annual opportunity to nominate potential winners of County and National awards.
- An annual opportunity to nominate local charities to benefit from the proceeds of the Charity Sims event.

Clubs do not pay a separate affiliation subscription to the County.
