<u>Windows</u> – Lesley Simmons said that we had had to spend a considerable amount of money having the windows repaired by a joiner and then repainted inside and outside. We need to look after the windows because they had rotted due to the very large amount of condensation that collects on the windows. We have purchased two dehumidifiers that are put on at every session. These need emptying and Lesley asked that all members be aware that these need emptying regularly and perhaps they could help in this matter. The blinds are drawn sometimes because of the sun but it is imperative during the winter that they are re-opened before leaving, as leaving them closed allows even more condensation to build up on the windows. The opposite is true in the summer when leaving the blinds closed keeps the room cooler.

<u>Chairs</u> – The question of new chairs was raised. JB reported that this is an on-going project as we need to find the correct chair to suit most people.

<u>Tables</u> – Some of the bridge tables are in need of repair and Roger Bill said he thought he knew someone who could do this job.

<u>Snooker</u> –

Robbie Fowler said that he had heard that the Club was thinking of introducing an electronic system of booking. He said he was very against this and all of the snooker players he had spoken to did not want this either and as they are mostly elderly would not be able to use it. He did agree that the snooker players would use the weekly schedules that have been introduced. However, Dinah Honey did not agree with this and so the matter is on-going.
