1NT System works very well.

***Disrupt it if you can!***

**DONT**

**Over Opp's 1 NT:**

**X = A single suited hand (6+)**

**1 ♣ = ♣s + higher suit (5/5)**

**1 ♦ = ♦s + higher suit (5/5)**

**1 ♥ = ♥s + ♠s**

**♠ = ♠s. X then ♠s = stronger hand**

**2 NT = Both minors (5/5)**

# What do I Need?

At least 7 pts

Most of the points in the suits

After 1NT,P,P...? What you don't have  
your P does. "I can't stand to pass" L.

**Does it have to be 5/5? No**

**A good 4 carder (that's  
likely to be the one P picks)**

## *Responses*

**Over 1♣ or  Pass w 3 cards**

**W/O support;**

**Bid next suit. P will pass or correct.**

**Over , Pass or correct to **

**A raise in P suit is mildly invitational and is usually passed**

**With a good hand you can bid 2NT to ask P to describe her hand (Discuss w P)**

**If responder bids over P's DONT call,**

**X or XX asks P to name unknown suit.**
